

Can the World Survive Donald Trump?

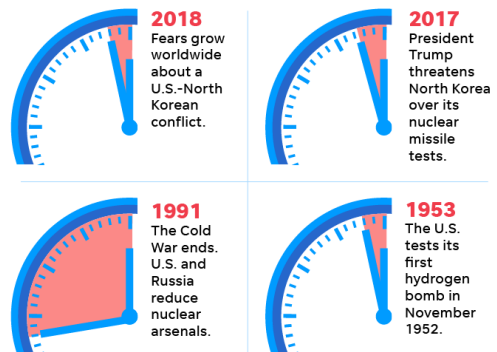
An Evening with US Peace Activist John Catalinotto



Donald Trump is certainly one of the most controversial presidents in US history. Trump's climate change denial and warlike policy combined with his waywardness have been significant factors in the decision of the board of the *Bulletin of Atomic Scientists* to move the minute hand of their famous Doomsday's Clock to two minutes before midnight, "the closest the Clock has ever been to Doomsday" (the single time it was as close was 1953).

Can the world, will the world survive this situation?
The US peace activist John Catalinotto say yes – but only by dedicated struggle.

John Catalinotto has been a peace activist since the Cuban missile crisis in October 1962 and was particularly active against the US war in Vietnam (1960-1975). He is a member of the International Action Center founded by former US Attorney General Ramsey Clark and has fought against the US and NATO wars against Yugoslavia, Iraq, Afghanistan, Libya and Syria as well as against the US interventions in Central America.

He also supports social movements such as "Black Lives Matter." He has been the chief editor of the leftist weekly Workers World since 1982 and has edited two books on US wars. His own book Turn the Guns Around: Mutinies, Soldier Revolts and Revolutions, which he will be presenting at the event, appeared in 2017.
